Type 2 Diabetes Management in Primary Care: The Role of ...

No one in the know doubts that most diabetes care is done by primary care providers. No more than 20% of people with diabetes ever see an endocrinologist, and there are not nearly enough endocrinologists to handle the ever-increasing number of people with diabetes. The vast majority of diabetes management is, and in my view should be, in the hands of generalists.
