Long-Term Prognosis for Epilepsy and Seizure Disorders

Hippocampal sclerosis was associated with a good outcome but declined in relative frequency over the years. Conclusion: The vast majority of patients who were not seizure free experienced at least a substantial and long-lasting reduction in seizure frequency. A positive long-term outcome after epilepsy surgery is possible for many patients and especially those with hippocampal sclerosis or those who had anterior temporal lobe resections.

The long-term outcomes of epilepsy surgery

The long-term outcome is often predictable by observation of the early outcome of seizures. One third of children with epilepsy are mentally retarded. Poor social outcome is related to associated neurological disabilities, drug resistant seizures and polytherapy.

The long-term outcomes of epilepsy surgery

We reviewed 37 studies reporting long term outcomes after a status epilepticus (SE) episode in pediatric and adult populations. Study design, length of follow up, outcome measures, domains investigated (mortality, SE recurrence, subsequent epilepsy, cognitive outcome, functional outcome, or quality of life), and predictors of long term outcomes are summarized.

Long-term outcomes of reoperations in epilepsy surgery

In adults, the best long-term seizure outcome was after TLR (63% seizure-free, sustained seizure freedom since surgery in 44%). In children the TLR outcome (60% seizure-free, 55% with sustained seizure freedom) was matched by the long-term hemispherectomy results (60% seizure-free, all with sustained seizure freedom).

We report long-term outcome of surgery for epilepsy in 615 adults (497 anterior temporal resections, 40 temporal lesionectomies, 40 extratemporal lesionectomies, 20 extratemporal resections, 11 hemispherectomies, and seven palliative procedures [corpus callosotomy, subpial transection]), with prospective annual follow-up for a median of 8 years (range 1 – 19).

Long-term data on neurostimulation outcome do, however, provide evidence for a sustained, possibly increased, efficacy in patients with pharmacoresistant epilepsy, and the degree of seizure reduction and responder rates compares favorably with medical treatment.

Multivariate analysis identified 30 seizures/month at baseline and long epilepsy duration as negative predictors and positive MRI to be a positive predictor of long-term seizure-free outcome. Ten years after surgery, 86% of seizure-free children and 43% of seizure-free adults had stopped AEDs in the surgery groups compared to none of the controls (p < 0.0005).
