The Pecs attach to the humerus near the shoulder joint and originate on the breastbone in the center of the chest. Moves the humerus across the chest. Pectoralis Minor. The Pectoralis Minor muscle is located underneath the pectoralis major muscle, attaching to the coracoid process of the scapula and originating on the middle ribs.

Stimulation of muscle contraction Neurons, or nerve cells, are stimulated when the polarity across their plasma membrane changes. The polarity change, called an action potential, travels along the neuron until it reaches the end of the neuron.
