The United States signed the Treaty of Amity and Cooperation (TAC) in 2009 and was the first non-ASEAN country to establish a resident ambassador and permanent mission to the organization. The United States joined the East Asia Summit (EAS) in 2011, and began to hold annual ASEAN-US Summits in 2012. In 2015, the US-ASEAN relationship was raised to a strategic partnership, and in 2016 the first leader-level US-ASEAN Summit in the United States was held at Sunnylands in Rancho Mirage, California.

U.S. Engagement with ASEAN. The United States began engaging with ASEAN as a dialogue partner in 1977, and has cooperated with ASEAN ever since.
